

## THEATER MATERIALS

You will need the following sizes of Crescent mat board, 4= 20x29 and 2-26x20 of either # 1053 or # 1081 along with a 20x20 sheet of window glass for reflections on the stage area. 1/8<sup>th</sup> plywood can be glued to the mat sections of the set up for stiffening the stage wings and back.

To make base patterns, such as squares or vanishing lines, lay down masking tape and spray paint it first white and then the color, with fluorescent color and then cut the painted tape into strips and apply to the base material and then cover with glass to prevent the strips from flaking off the lines.

(Note fluorescent paint flakes and you should keep a soft brush available to clean the stage area or your picture will have little fluorescent specks in the area.)

### PAINT DROP PHOTO EQUIPMENT

- 1- 4-inch petri dish with about 1/4 to 3/8ths inch of mineral oil.
- 2- Fluorescent paint of different colors
- 3- An eye dropper
- 4- Tooth picks
- 5- Black construction paper
- 6- A backlight fixture for each side
- 7- Tripod
- 8- Macro or close focusing capabilities, close up or plus lenses
- 9- Daylight film or digital media,

Place the petri dish with oil on the black paper, add the paint by the drop in the color scheme that you want and then move the paint around with a toothpick to create a composition that pleases you, then light and photograph.
