

Seacoast Camera Club Print Competition Entry Rules For Seacoast Club competitions and NECCC print competitions

NECCC Print Competitions are open, no assigned categories You may enter 1 COLOR and 1 B&W print.

Club Print Competitions may have assigned categories and limits on entries. (Check Current Program schedule)

Print Size For Club and NECCC Competitions

Minimum print size is 8"x10" i.e. an 8"x10" print matted into an 11"x14" Mat (outside mat dimensions).

Maximum print size is 16"x20" The Print must be mounted on foam core etc. Not to exceed 16"x20".

Maximum outside dimensions of any print or mat, not to exceed 16"x20".

Panorama's Print or Matted Size not to exceed 16" x 20" (outside dimensions).

Prints in frames or under glass are not permitted.

Prints mounted on Plexiglas or composite wood material are not permitted.

Photographers will enter prints as a group A, group B, or Masters competitor.

Class B is for new or lesser experienced photographers.

Class A is for more experienced photographers.

Class M is for very experienced photographers or professionals.

You may choose which class you would like to compete in. You will stay in the class for the competition year. You may not switch classes during the year.


Note: If you have averaged a high print score during the year in class B or A, you will automatically be moved up to the next group the following year.

Print Identification Labels

Print ID labels are to be filled out and placed at the **top left hand corner** on the back of your mat or print mount, with the arrow pointing to top of print. **All prints must have the Print ID label on the back with your group marked B, A or M in the appropriate box.**

Print ID labels are available from the club.

The first sheet is free (10 labels) thereafter, they are \$1.00 a sheet (10 labels) to cover part of the cost of labels and printing.

Judging

A panel of intra-club judges or an independent judge or judges will score prints on a point system. Constructive critique by judges after the competition.

Awards

Ribbons will be awarded for each print competition.

Print of the Year Awards

The final print competition of the year.

You may enter any print that has won 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in the club during the current competition season. (Sept.—April) Including Club and NECCC qualifying competitions.

One Print of the Year award will be given in Class B, Class A and Class M.
